**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN REG. CRI. BAIL APPLICATION No.93/2026**  
**Pankaj Ashok Sonone + 2 Vs The State of Maharashtra**

**( Passed on 17.3.2026 )**

1] Present application has been filed by the applicants/accused namely Pankaj Ashok Sonone, Kailas Prakash Daberao and Vishal Ramdas Shelarkar, under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail, in Crime No.75/2026 registered at Police Station Shegaon Rural, Tq.Shegaon, Dist.Buldhana for the offence punishable under Sections 309(6), 308(3), 318(4), 205 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2] Investigating officer and learned APP Shri S.B.Ingle have resisted the application by filing say at Exh.6. It is contended that alleged offence is serious and cognizable offence. If accused released on bail then they will assist to the absconded accused Vikas Patil and destroy the evidence. It is contended that if accused released on bail then they will pressurize the complainant and prosecution witnesses and commit the similar offence. Moreover, if they released on bail then they will not attend the police station or Court. Hence, they requested to reject the application.

3] learned advocate Shri S.S. Badgujar for applicants/accused has submitted that applicants are arrested on 28.2.2026 and they were remanded in police custody till 4.3.2026. They are permanent resident

of Shegaon Taluka and complainant is resident of Madhya Pradesh. Therefore, no possibility to pressurize him by the accused. He submitted that nothing has to recover from the applicants. He further submitted that the applicants are ready to co operate the Investigating officer in investigation. They are ready to abide each and every condition imposed, if they released on bail. Hence, he urged that considering the ground of application accused may be released on bail.

4] Learned APP Shri B.S.Ingle, has argued as per the say and urged to reject the application.

5] I have thoughtfully considered the submission of both sides. Perused the application, say filed by the I.O., APP. I have perused the documents placed on record by the applicants/accused as well as the police papers and case diary.

6] As per contents of FIR, complainant Indrakumar Munnilal Yadav R/o. Madhya Pradesh State, has lodged the report against Vikas Patil and other three unknown person. It is alleged that he is working as a singer in Orchestra. Before three days he has seen the double currency post of his face book account Indra Lal Yadav, in which it was mentioned that to double the money to contact on mobile phone No.8269186752. Therefore, he made phone call and came to know it. It was phone call of Vikas Patil. Said Vikas Patil told him that his office is at Shegaon and to come at his office and deposit Rs.1,00,000/- and he will give him Rs.5,00,000/-. Therefore, complainant on 26.2.2026 left the house to reach the Shegaon. He reached at Shegaon at about 10.30 p.m. on 27.2.2026. When he made phone call to the above said

number, at that time said person asked him to stop at Shegaon Railway Station. Again said person made him phone call and asked him to come near the bridge of Shegaon Railway Station. Therefore, he went there and one person told him that he is Vikas Patil and he had made phone call to him. Thereafter, he along with Vikas Patil went outside the Shegaon Railway Station. Vikas Patil made phone call to other person. Within short time one black Honda Shine motorcycle came there. The rider of the said motorcycle was wearing white shirt and black pant. Therefore, complainant, Vikas Patil and said person went at 4-5 K.M. distance from the Shegaon Railway Station. There was already one Activa scooter having police symbol. There were two unknown person on the said Activa. Vikas Patil asked him whether he brought cash Rs.1,00,000/-. Complainant said no. Therefore, all the four persons hold the complainant and started to search him. They have forcibly taken Rs.4000/- from his pocket and asked him to make phone call to his family members and demand Rs.1,00,000/- on account pay, otherwise they will broke his hand and legs. Therefore, due to fear, he transferred Rs.4000/- on the QR Code of unknown person accompanied with Vikas Patil. Said person told him that why he brought the less amount and he kicked him. Due to it he fallen down. When complainant told that he will make police complaint, they told that they are police person. It is alleged that at about 12.30 p.m. he rescued himself and made phone call on No.112. But he could not understand the language of the police. Hence, he cut the phone number. Thereafter, he lodged the report.

7] The police papers shows that applicants are arrested on 28.2.2026 and since then they are behind the bar. They are already

interrogated by the police. Nothing has to recover from them. Therefore, no purpose would be served keeping the applicants behind bar. They are ready to co-operate the police in investigation and abide each and every condition imposed, if they released on bail. Therefore, though the prosecution has resisted the application, but if the applicants/accused released on bail on certain conditions, then prosecution will not be prejudiced. To arrest the absconded accused, the presence of present applicants is not disputed. Hence, application deserves to be allowed. In result, I pass the following order :-

**ORDER**

(1)	Application Exh.1 is allowed.
(2)	The applicants/accused namely Pankaj Ashok Sonone, Kailas Prakash Daberao and Vishal Ramdas Shelarkar, shall be released on bail in connection with Crime No.75/2026 registered at Police Station Shegaon Rural, Tq.Shegaon, Dist.Buldhana for the offence punishable under Sections 309(6), 308(3), 318(4), 205 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, on executing PR bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five Thousand only) each and surety bond in like amount each.
(3)	They shall appear before the investigating officer at concerned Police Station on every Monday, Wednesday and Saturday between 2 p.m.to 5 p.m. till filing final report.
(4)	They shall not pressurize the complainant and prosecution witnesses.
(5)	Bail before concerned JMFC Court.
(6)	Hamdast allowed.
