State Vs. SakhaUlla Khan +3

ORDER BELOW EXH. 19

This application is filed by accused no. 2 namely Zahir Khan Hamid Khan for grant of permission to go abroad for Hujh purpose. The applicant stated that he is a permanent resident of Lakhanwada Ta-Khamgaon and all relatives are also resident of Khamgaon. Applicant wanted to go for Umrah at Saudi Arabia therefore he wanted new passport. Passport authority had mentioned to applicant that gave permission from Court because of his pending case. If he is not permitted to go abroad, he would sustain huge loss which can not be compensated in terms of money. This is a spiritual loss So also it would be resulted into curtailing of his fundamental rights. He is ready to follow all conditions which will be imposed by the Court.

2] Learned APP filed say and stated that if permission is granted to the accused, the matter will be prolonged and prayed to reject the application.

3] Perused the application, say and record. Heard both sides.

4] This case is pending against the accused for the offense punishable U/sec. 324, 323, 504, 506, 34 of Indian Penal Code, The case is pending for Charge. As per submission of the accused, he desires to go at abroad for spiritual purpose.

5] Perused record the present application is not for seeking permission for leaving the territory of India the present application is only for seeking permission for issuance of passport and no objection of this Court in that respect. Hence, taking into consideration the entire

facts and circumstance of this case I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The applicant i.e. accused no.2 namely Zahir Khan Hamid Khan is hereby granted only no objection permission for obtaining Indian Passport.
- 3 The Court has no objection in regard of this case only for issuing Indian Passport to accused no. 2 Zahir Khan Hamid Khan on fulfilling legal requirements as per the Indian Passport Act.
