This is an application for release of vehicle bearing no. DL-1LAR-2723 on superdari on behalf of applicant namely Khem Singh.

IO has filed his reply.

1. Submissions heard. Record perused. As per the report of IO, police has no objection if the said vehicle is released to the applicant /registered owner of the vehicle.
2. Keeping in view the report of IO and law laid down by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in case titled as ***Manjit Singh Vs State; Crl. M.C.4485 /2013 and Crl. M.A.No. 16055/2013*** wherein, inter-alia the law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in case titled as ***Sunderbhai Ambalal Desai and C.M. Mudaliar Vs. State of Gujrat; (2002) 10 SSC 283*** has been reiterated, IO as well as SHO, PS concerned are directed as under:

(i) To release the above mentioned vehicle to applicant/registered owner subject to preparation of detailed panchnama of above mentioned vehicle and upon verification of applicant as owner of the vehicle.

(ii) Take photographs of above mentioned vehicle from all possible angles including engine number and chasis number and file the same along with charge sheet.

(iii) To take a security bond from applicant/registered owner for an amount **as per the valuation of the above said vehicle.** **IO is directed to get the valuation of the vehicle done and prepare valuation report prior to release of the same to the applicant/registered owner.**

(iv) To release the above said vehicle with direction to applicant/registered owner to indemnify to the amount mentioned in the report of IO, in case any claim regarding ownership of vehicle in question arises in future.

(v) To get panchnama and photographs, along with negatives, of above mentioned vehicle, attested and countersigned by complainant, affected party as well as by applicant and IO.

(vi) To keep on record the permanent address of the applicant, his identity proof, address proof as well as phone number.

(vii) The production of panchnama and photographs of the vehicle during trial would suffice for the purpose of evidence.

3. Application moved by applicant stands disposed of as allowed in above terms. Papers be tagged with the case record. IO/SHO is directed to do the needful within a maximum of one week from today. Copy of this order be given sent to the IO/SHO and be also given dasti to Ld. Counsel for applicant.
