



**Order below Exhibit .no.16**

This application has filed by petitioner and submitted that the direction be given to the non-applicant to file fresh affidavit of assets & liabilities with supporting documents.

2. The petitioner submits that the non-applicant has failed to filed an affidavit of assets & liabilities as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Furthermore,the non-applicant did not disclose the correct information in his affidavit of assets & liabilities of dated 20-02-2026 .The petitioner states that while the non-applicant holds a is diploma holder in electric engineering, he falsely represents his education as a B.A.

3. Similarly, while he claims to be a labourer, he is actually involved in a hotel business,works as agriculturist, and hold other employments. His parents also own agricultural land and are involved in the hotel business,despite his false claim that they are dependent on him. Therefore, the petitioner has prayed that the affidavit of assets & liabilities filed by the non-applicant

which is filed on 20-02-2026 be rejected and direction be given to the non-applicant to file fresh affidavit of assets & liabilities with supporting documents.

4. The non-applicant has not filed his say on this application .Hence, this application is proceeded without the say of the non-applicant.

5. Heard the argument of the applicant's advocate.

6. The applicant has filed a copy of salary slip of may -2022 of Bharat Financial Inclusion Limited, a copy of T.C. issued by the GRAMIN polytechnic Vishnupuri,Nanded, college, two copies of 7/12 extracts photos of hotels and copy of certificate issued to non-applicant for his performance in his service which are listed at Exhibit. no.18. On perusal of all above documents it reveals that the non-applicant has provided false information regarding his education and income in affidavit of assets & liabilities . Moreover he did not supply supporting documents. Thus, It can be seen that the non-applicant has not filed affidavit of assets & liabilities as per the direction of The Hon'ble Supreme Court **In Rajnesh v. Neha (2020)**.

7. In view of above discussion, I am of the view that the petitioner has shown that the non-applicant has not filed affidavit of assets & liabilities as per the

direction of The Hon'ble Supreme Court. Therefore, it is necessary to discard the affidavit of assets & liabilities which is filed by the non-applicant on 20-02-2026. Similarly, it is necessary to give direction to the non-applicant to file a fresh affidavit of assets & liabilities with supporting documents.

8. Accordingly, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. The application at Exhibit. no.16 in PWDVA Appln.83/2025 is hereby allowed.
2. The affidavit of assets & liabilities which is filed by the non-applicant on 20-02-2026 is hereby discarded.
3. The non-applicant is hereby directed to file a fresh affidavit of assets & liabilities along with supporting documents, as per the direction of The Hon'ble supreme court **In Rajnesh v. Neha (2020).** as per ANNEXURE-A1, with in 15 days from the date of passing this order.
