**Judgment**

(Delivered on 31/03/2026)

This is an application filed under section VIII(2) of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 for issuing legal heirship certificate.

2. It is submitted that applicant No.1, 8 and 9 are son and daughter of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade. Applicant No.2 is the daughter-in-law of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade and applicant No.3 to 7 are the grand son and grand daughter of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade. Gangubail Tulshiram Dabhade, wife of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade, died on 09.02.2023. Digambar Motiram Dabhade, son of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade, died on 21.06.2016. Applicant No.2 and applicant No.3 to 7 are widow and son and daughter of Digambar Motiram Dabhade. Deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade died on 10.01.2003 at Padsul, Tq. Shegaon, Dist. Buldana. Thus, applicant No.1 to 9 are the only legal heirs of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade. Applicants need legal heirship certificate for Government and semi Government purpose. Hence, applicants filed the present application.

3. Following points arose for my consideration for the determination of this case and my findings thereon with reason to follow.

**: REASON :**

**As to point No.1 and 2 :-**

4. The applicant No.1 has led his evidence by way of evidence affidavit (Exh.14) in support of their claim. Original copy of death certificate (Exh.15 to 17) of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade, Gangubai Tulshiram Dabhade and Digambar Tulshiram Dabhade show that they are dead. Heirship certificate (Exh.18 and 19) issued by Sarpanch, Padsul, Tq. Shegaon show that applicants are the only legal heir of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade.

5. The proclamation (Exh.29) was published in daily news paper Lokopchar dated 11.11.2025 inviting objection within 30 days but none has appeared and raised objection until now. Notice inviting objection was also affixed on the notice board of Civil & Criminal Court, Shegaon and Grampanchayat, Padsul and notice was also affixed on the house of the deceased. Needless to say that, the issuance of heirship certificate does not confer any right on any person in respect of property of deceased. The issuance of heirship certificate in the name of applicants is the formal recognition of the applicants as legal heirs of the deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade and the applicants have established their said claim.

Considering the documentary and oral evidence on record, I am satisfied that applicants are legal heir of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade. Therefore, it is just and desirable to issue legal heirship certificate in favour of applicant. Hence, I answer the point No.1 and 2 in affirmative and in answer to point No.3, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. The application is allowed.
2. It is hereby declare that applicants are legal heir of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade. Legal heirship certificate be issued in the name of applicant No.1 Gotiram Tulshiram Dabhade, applicant No.2 Sunanda Digamabar Dabhade, applicant No.3 Laxmi Ravindra Tayde, applicant No.4 Rekha Ravindra Khanderao, applicant No.5 Usha Ramrao Dongre, applicant No.6 Meena Sagar Sardar, applicant No.7 Nandkishor Dagamber Dabhade, applicant No.8 Mathurabai Pralad Sapkal and applicant No.9 Trigunabai Vishwas Wankhade, as they are the only legal heirs of deceased Tulshiram Motiram Dabhade on payment of requisite court fees.
