**Judgment**

(Delivered on 04/04/2026)

This is an application filed under section VIII(2) of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 for issuing legal heirship certificate.

2. It is submitted that the applicant No.1 is the daughter-in-law of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal and deceased Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal, applicant No.2 and 3 are the grand son and grand daughter of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal and deceased Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal and applicant No.4 and 5 are the daughters of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal and deceased Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal. Deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal died on 20/03/2013 at Shegaon, Tq. Shegaon, Dist. Buldana. So also deceased Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal died on 12/05/2021 at Shegaon, Tq. Shegaon, Dist. Buldana. Vinod Mohanlal Agrawal, son of the deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal and deceased Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal, died on 30/12/2018 at Shegaon, Tq. Shegaon, Dist. Buldana. Applicant No.1 is the widow and and applicant No.2 and 3 are the son and daughter of deceased Vinod Mohanlal Agrawal. Thus, all the applicants are the legal heir of Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal. Applicants need legal heirship certificate for Government and semi Government purpose. Hence, applicants filed the present application.

3. Following points arose for my consideration for the determination of this case and my findings thereon with reason to follow.

1. Whether applicants prove that they are the only legal heirs of the deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal ?

**: REASON :**

**As to point No.1 and 2 :**

4. The applicant No.1 has led her evidence by way of evidence affidavit (Exh.11) in support of their claim. Original copy of death certificate (Exh.12 to 14) of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal, Nirmalabai Mohanlal Agrawal and Vinod Mohanlal Agrawal disclosed that they are dead. Heirship certificate (Exh.15) issued by Corporator, Shailesh Patokar of Municipal Council, Shegaon also show that applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal.

5. The proclamation (Exh.21) was published in daily news paper Lokopchar dated 21.01.2026 inviting objection within 30 days but none has appeared and raised objection until now. Notice inviting objection was also affixed on the notice board of Civil & Criminal Court, Shegaon, Nagar Parishad Shegaon and notice was also affixed on the house of the applicants. Needless to say that, the issuance of heirship certificate does not confer any right on any person in respect of property of deceased. The issuance of heirship certificate in the name of applicants is the formal recognition of the applicants as legal heirs of the deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal and the applicants have established their said claim. Considering the documentary and oral evidence on record, I am satisfied that applicants are heirs of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal. Therefore, it is just and desirable to issue legal heirship certificate in favour of applicants. Hence, I answer the point No.1 and 2 in affirmative and in answer to point No.3, I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

1. The application is allowed.
2. It is hereby declared that applicants are legal heirs of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal. Legal heirship certificate be issued in the name of applicant No.1 Smt. Dhanshri Vinod Agrawal, applicant No.2 Sahil Vinod Agrawal, applicant No.3 Sau. Sejal Shubham Todi, applicant No.4 Sau. Sadhana Ashoklalaji Agrawal and applicant No.5 Sau. Jyoti Dipak Agrawal, as they are the only legal heir of deceased Mohanlal Hiralal Agrawal on payment of requisite court fees.
