ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 1

(Passed on this 25th day of April, 2024)

1. This is a complaint under section 294, 323, 504 and 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
2. Perused the complaint, substance of examination of the complainant and the documents on record.
3. The complainant has alleged that the accused no. 1 is her husband, accused no. 2 and 3 are her mother-in-law and father-in-law respectively and accused no. 4 is her brother-in-law. It is the case of the complainant that the accused no. 1 to 4 have been continuously harrasing the complainant since the time of her marriage. It is also the case of the complainant that on 05-08-23 the accused no. 1 to 4 assaulted and threatened the complainant. Moreover, they abused her in filthy language. Hence, she had filed report at Police Station Tamgaon, Sangrampur. However, the said authorities failed to take cognizance of her report. Hence, this complaint.
4. The complainant narrated the incident and attributed specific role to the accused as per her verification statement. The complainant has also supported the present complainant along with N.C.R. no. 443/2023 which indicate dispute between the complainant and the accused. However, there is stark veracity as regards to the nature of threats with respect to the life of the complainant. Hence, at this juncture it would not be just and proper to attach an aggravated offence against the accused.

5. Hence, at this juncture based on the verification statement of the complainant and the documents on record there is *prima facie* material against the accused in respect of section 294, 323, 504 and 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code. Therefore, there are sufficient grounds to proceed against the accused and hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

1. Issue process against the accused for the offence punishable under section 294, 323, 504 and 506 read with section 34 of the Indian Penal Code *vide* section 204 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. It be registered as Summons Criminal Case.
