JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 14.03.2026)

1. The P.S.O., Sakharkherda charge-sheeted the accused for the offence punishable under section 6(b)r/w 24 of the Cigarettes and other tobacco products, 2003.

2. The particulars of the above offence read over and explained to the accused in vernacular. To which the accused voluntarily pleads guilty of the said offence. Accused has filed pursis at **Exh.02** and pleaded guilty. The plea of the accused being voluntary and unconditional, I accept the same and hold the accused guilty of the offence punishable under section 6(b)r/w 24 of the Cigarettes and other tobacco products, 2003. Consequences of pleading guilty has been explained to the accused. I heard accused on quantum of penalty. Accused submitted that, he is sole bread earner of the family. Hence, pleaded for leniency and imposing less amount of penalty. Considering the fact that the accused was involved in the above said offence, one opportunity has to be given to him. Considering age of the accused and responsibility of his family, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Accused **Ramesh Konduji Aavhale**, is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under section 6(b)r/w 24 of the Cigarettes and other tobacco products, 2003 vide section 275 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sannhita (B.N.S.S.), 2023 and he is sentenced to pay fine of **Rs. 100/- (Rupee One hundred Only)**, in default to suffer simple imprisonment of 01 day.
