You, on or about 03/02/2026, at about 18.00 hours, at At Shendurjan, which is a public place, did play, participate, engage, or attempt to engage in gambling, using cards as a means of gambling, and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 12A of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887 (Bombay Act No. IV of 1887, as extended to and in force in the State of Maharashtra), which offence is within the cognizance of this Court.

Q.8 : Have you received copies to police papers?

Q.9 : Do you plead guilty?

Order

1. The accused has appeared suo motu before this Special Court. The prosecution has filed a Charge-sheet against the accused alleging that he has committed an offence punishable under Section 12A of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887. The particulars of the said offence were explained to the accused in Marathi, to which he pleaded guilty. The accused has also filed a Purnis at **(Exh.2)**, stating therein that he is voluntarily confessing to the offence.

2. Upon examination of the accused, it appears that he has pleaded guilty voluntarily and without any coercion, undue influence, or threat. The learned counsel for the accused further submitted that the accused is fully aware of the consequences of confessing the offence and that he is pleading guilty voluntarily. The accused has voluntarily admitted his guilt despite the consequences of the punishment having been explained to him in the vernacular language. In view of the voluntary plea tendered by the accused, I accept the plea of guilt and proceed to pass the following order in the interest of justice.

OPERATIVE ORDER

1. The accused is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under Section 12A of the Bombay

Prevention of Gambling Act, 1887, and in view of Section 275 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita,

2. He is sentenced to suffer imprisonment till the rising of the Court and to pay a fine of ₹300/- (Rupees Three Hundred only); and in default of payment of the fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for one day.
3. The seized muddemal amount of Rs. 1615/- shall be forfeited and credited to the Government.
4. The pen, playing cards, and other instruments of gambling shall be destroyed after the expiry of the appeal period.
