**Order below Exh.1**

1. The present Miscellaneous Civil Application has been filed seeking revocation of the heirship certificate issued in Miscellaneous Application No. 21/2019 in favour of the non-applicant, namely Vishwajeet Baliram Patil.

2. During pendency of the present proceedings, the sole non-applicant, Vishwajeet Baliram Patil, expired on 02.10.2024. The applicants contend that the deceased expired without leaving behind any legal heirs and therefore seek revocation of the heirship certificate.

3. This Court, vide earlier directions, required the applicants to issue a paper proclamation in the locality where the deceased ordinarily resided, inviting objections and claims from persons asserting heirship.

4. Pursuant thereto, the applicants published the proclamation. In response, Meena Vishwajeet Patil filed an application at (Exhibit-62) claiming to be the legal heir of the deceased. Likewise, Akash Patil along with five others filed an application at (Exhibit-68) asserting their status as

legal heirs of the deceased and seeking to be joined as non-applicants in place of Vishwajeet Patil.

5. In view of the rival claims, it is necessary for this Court to conduct an enquiry to determine who are the lawful heirs of deceased Vishwajeet Baliram Patil and who are entitled to be substituted in his place to contest the present application.

6. Accordingly, it is directed that: The claims put forth at (Exhibit-62 and Exhibit-68) shall be taken on record. The matter be fixed for enquiry into the legal heirship of deceased Vishwajeet Baliram Patil. Parties shall lead evidence, oral and documentary, in support of their respective claims. Upon conclusion of such enquiry, appropriate orders shall be passed regarding substitution of legal heirs in place of the deceased non-applicant.
