Ld. Counsel for accused has stated that accused is in custody since 16.04.2026. It is further argued that the allegations made against accused are false and there is no requirement of custodial interrogation of the accused in the present case.

Per contra, Ld. APP for the State along with IO have opposed the present bail application that the offence alleged in the present matter is serious in nature and recovery has been effected from the possession of the accused.

Arguments heard. Record perused.

Briefly, the case of the prosecution is that present FIR was registered on the complaint of complainant regarding theft of his mobile phone and subsequent online withdrawal of Rs. 2,42,998/- through misuse of the stolen mobile phone. The allegations against the applicant is regarding the theft of mobile phone and subsequent sale of mobile phone. Accused has remain in custody for nearly 50 days. No need of custodial interrogation has satisfactorily been explained by the prosecution. In view of the above-said discussion, present bail application is **allowed**. Without expression of any opinion on the merits of the case, present application is disposed off with the direction that applicant/accused

namely **Shahnawaz @ Murshid** be released on bail on furnishing personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand)** with one surety in the like amount. Accused is directed to appear before the Court on each date of hearing and shall not tamper with the evidence or attempt to influence witnesses. With these directions, bail application stands disposed off.

Application stands disposed off.
