Today is fixed for ex parte hearing.

Petitioner Sandhya Choudhary is present before the court along with her Ld. Lawyer. Petitioner is examined as P.W.-1. Birth certificate of the daughter of the petitioner is marked as Exhibit-1 and the Aadhaar Card of the petitioner is marked as Exhibit-2

For speedy disposal of this case, the case record is now taken up for passing ex- parte order.

This is a suit for divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion u/s. 13(1)(ia) & (ib) of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, filed by Petitioner / wife namely, Sandhya Choudhary against her husband/respondent namely, Rohit Choudhary @ Rohit Tiyaagi.

FINDINGS

In order to prove her case, the petitioner has examined herself as P.W.-1. Perused the ex-parte evidence of P.W.-1 and the documents filed by petitioner and the case record.

On careful perusal of the evidence of petitioner (P.W.-1), I am of the view that the petitioner's case for divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion has been proved by her ex-parte evidence. There is nothing to disbelieve the unchallenged oral testimony of P.W.-1. So, petitioner is entitled to get a decree of divorce on the ground of cruelty and desertion.

In the result, the suit succeeds ex-parte.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that Mat. Suit No. 289 of 2026 (CIS No.307 of 2026) be and the same is decreed ex-parte as against respondent without any order as to cost.

The petitioner namely, Sandhya Choudhary do get a decree of divorce against the respondent namely, Sri Rohit Choudhary @ Rohit Tiyaagi.

The Matrimonial tie in between the petitioner and the respondent, namely Sandhya Choudhary and Rohit Choudhary @ Rohit Tiyaagi, solemnised on 16.03.2010 as per Hindu Marriage Act,1955 is hereby dissolved by a decree of divorce.

The decree of divorce shall take effect from this date.
