COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH. 51 AND 53

Perused the application and say thereon. Heard Ld. Advocate for applicant/accused and Ld. Special P.P. for State. As per order dated 18.01.2025 passed below Exh. 5, my learned predecessor was pleased to release the applicant/accused on bail on furnishing PR bond of Rs. 50,000/- with one or more solvent sureties of like amount. The applicant/accused is unable to arrange the surety of aforesaid amount, therefore, he has made this application for reducing the amount of surety. He has also prayed for releasing him on PR bond.

It comes to my knowledge that the applicant/accused is unable to arrange the surety of aforesaid amount, therefore since last one year inspite of bail order, he is in custody. The applicant/accused is in custody, therefore he is unable to arrange surety. The applicant/accused undertakes that after releasing from jail, he will furnish surety of aforesaid amount within 15 days. Considering the inability of applicant/accused to furnish the surety of aforesaid amount, I come to

the conclusion for releasing him on executing PR bond of Rs. 50,000/-.
Thus I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

- 1) The applicant/accused is hereby released on executing PR bond of Rs. 50,000/-.
- 2) He is directed to furnish the surety of Rs. 50,000/- within 15 days of his release from Jail.
- 3) Rest of the conditions of order dtd. 18.01.2025 passed below Exh. 5 shall remain unchanged.
- 4) The applicant/accused is directed to attend the Court dates punctually.
