

**ORDER BELOW EXH.1****(Dated 01/04/2026)**

This is an application for seeking legal heir-ship certificate under the Bombay Regulation Act No. VIII, 1827. The applicant is daughter of the deceased **Shankar Jairam Gedam** who expired on 30/05/2024 at Ballarpur, Tal. Ballarpur, Dist. Chandrapur. So also mother of applicant viz. Parvatabai Shankar Gedam also expired on 06/01/2023. Applicant is in need of legal heirship certificate for Government and semi Government purpose. Hence, she prayed for issuing legal heir-ship certificate in her favour.

2] Read the contents of the application, affidavit of applicant Vaishali Sachin Gawande has filed at **(Exh.10)** and perused the documents on record.

3] Heard the learned Advocate for the applicant.

4] Public notice and proclamation has been issued. No one has appeared to challenge the contents of application and affidavit at **Exh.10** filed by applicant. The Death certificate and Aadhar card of deceased **Shankar Jairam Gedam** are at **Exh.11 & 13** respectively. The Death certificate and election card of mother of applicant are at **Exh.12 & 14** respectively. Aadhar card of applicant is at **Exh.15**.

5] Despite issuance of paper publication, nobody has turned up before this Court and contested this application. The receipt of paper publication dated 11/09/2025 (Navrashtra) is at **Exh.17**. The contents of affidavit at **Exh.10** have remained uncontroverted. There is no reason disbelieve the version of

applicant on oath. Therefore, having perused the affidavit and connected documents with meticulous care, I am satisfied that applicant Vaishali Sachin Gawande is class-1 legal heir of deceased **Shankar Jairam Gedam**. All the procedural requirements are complied with and I find no justifiable reason to reject the application. In the result, I pass the following order:-

: O R D E R :

1. This application is hereby allowed.
2. Issue heir-ship certificate in the name of the applicant Vaishali Sachin Gawande as class-1 legal heirs of deceased **Shankar Jairam Gedam** as per section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act VIII, 1827 on payment of requisite Court Fee, if required to pay any, as per law.
3. The note shall be appended to the certificate as per Bombay Regulation Act No. VIII, 1827 and as provided at Para 312 of the Civil Manual.
