01] Today, the mentally ill person i.e. unknown female is produced by W.H.G. Sushma Wakde, B.No.311 of Police Station, Bhadrawati. The application is filed by P.S.O. Bhadrawati for admission of unknown female in Psychiatrist Regional Mental Hospital, Nagpur in view of medical report issued by Civil Surgeon, Chandrapur.

02] It is the contention of applicant that, on 04/03/2026, the patient was admitted at General Hospital, Chandrapur and after treatment, she is discharged today on 11/03/2026 from General Hospital, Chandrapur. The Civil Surgeon of General Hospital, Chandrapur had given letter to Police Station, Bhadrawati to admit the patient in Psychiatrist Regional Mental Hospital, Nagpur. The said letter along with medical paper are enclosed with application.

03] Gone through the assessment carried out by Psychiatrist, General Hospital, Chandrapur of which report is below (**Exh.3, Exh.4**) in which there is observation of Psychiatrist to the effect that, unknown female, Age 30 years, is suffering from "**Schizophrenia**". Several questions were asked to female in her mother language with the help of person who knows the language of female as well as other languages like Hindi and Marathi. From the conduct of female as well as opinion held by person who is aware about the mother tongue of female, it appears that, she has answered irrelevantly.

04] Therefore, in view of opinion held by Civil Surgeon, General Hospital, Chandrapur, it appears that, the unknown person, female of about 30 years old is required to be dealt with in accordance with provisions of Section 89 and 90 of The Mental Healthcare Act, 2017. In the result I passed the following order,

-:ORDER:-

1. Applicant is directed to convey the patient, unknown female to Psychiatrist Regional Mental Hospital, Nagpur for her admission and she be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Mental Healthcare Act, 2017.
2. Copy of the report (**Exh.3, Exh.4**) be sent along with reception order and issue reception order accordingly.
