



ORDER BELOW EXH.01

1] This is an application filed by the applicant under section 503 of BNSS, for releasing Mobile i.e. **Redmi, POCO C50, IMEI No. 868492066126288** and **868492066126236** seized in Crime No. 210/2026 punishable under section 79 and 296 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023. The said crime was registered at Gondpipri Police Station, Tah. Gondpipri and Dist. Chandrapur. Say of I.O. and Ld. APP filed on the record. Heard both sides. Perused the record.

2] Learned advocate for the applicant submitted that, the applicant is the owner of the seized mobile. Therefore, without the mobile applicant is facing various difficulties. Applicant requires said mobile and that he shall not misuse said mobile. The applicant is ready to abide conditions imposed by the court. He is also ready to produce the mobile as and when required. I.O. and Ld. APP have objection to release the said mobile on suprutnama bond to the applicant. I.O. submit that if mobile released on suprutnama accused may commit any other offence of same nature.

3] The applicant has produced verified copy of bill of Mobile and Aadhar card, etc. On the basis of these documents it appears that, the applicant is the owner of the said mobile. In case of not returning the same to the applicant, it would lay idle at the P.S. Gondpipri, Tah. Gondpipri, Dist. Chandrapur. I am satisfied that the applicant is the owner of the seized mobile. On



appropriate conditions said mobile can be returned to the applicant. Application cannot be rejected mere on the ground that accused may commit any other offence of same nature. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. The seized mobile i.e. **Redmi, POCO C50, IMEI No. 868492066126288 and 868492066126236** shall be handed over to the applicant namely, Arun Shankar Madavi, on his executing the indemnity bond of **Rs.6,500/-** (Rupees Six Thousand Five Hundred Only).
3. The applicant shall undertake to abide with following conditions till disposal of the matter in impugned crime :
 - I He shall not sell or transfer the said mobile.
 - II He shall not made any alteration or modification in the above said mobile.
 - III He shall produce the above said mobile as and when required during the investigation and trial.
4. The Investigation Officer shall hand over the above said mobile after receipt of the necessary documents thereof.
5. The Investigation Officer shall prepare a detailed panchnama thereof, also take the photographs from four sides of the above said mobile before returning the same at the expenses of the applicant and the said photographs and panchnama be present along with the charge-sheet.
6. Copy of this order be sent to the Investigation Officer.
7. Investigation Officer is directed to comply the order, as above before granting custody of mobile to the applicant.
