

ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN CRIMINAL MISC.APPLICATION NO.
200/2024

1] This is an application under Section 451 of Code of Criminal Procedure for releasing Honda Splendor bearing registration No. MH-12-UY-3610, seized during investigation in CR No. 53/2024 registered with Saswad police station.

2] The respondent has filed say and submitted to release the vehicle to the applicant on certain terms and conditions.

3] Heard. It seems that the police seized the above said vehicle during investigation in CR No. 53/2024. The applicant has filed on record verified copies of Tax Invoice of the vehicle, insurance policy of the vehicle and Aadhar Card of the applicant. It seems from the documents tendered by the applicant that the applicant is the registered owner of vehicle Honda Splendor bearing registration No. MH-12-UY-3610. The applicant has also filed affidavit vide Exh.4 along with the application. It is stated by the applicant that if the seized vehicle is kept in the police station in idle condition for uncertain period, there is every possibility of damage to the vehicle due to weather conditions. The applicant has specifically stated that he is ready to furnish bond against the said vehicle and he will not transfer the said vehicle.

4] It discloses that the applicant is in need of the said vehicle for his daily affairs and he is the owner of the vehicle. If the vehicle is not released, then there is every possibility of damage to the vehicle, if

it is kept in idle condition in the police station. In such circumstances, considering applicant's ownership of the vehicle, it is just in the interest of justice to release the said vehicle in favour of the applicant on certain conditions. Thus, the order -

ORDER

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] The two wheeler **Honda Splendor** bearing registration No. **MH-12-UY-3610**, Chassis no. **MBLHAW124NHL13435**, Engine no. **HA11EDNHL45939**, be released in favour of the applicant Akash Sham Dhumal, on execution of Supurtnama (Bond) of Rs. 50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only) on following conditions-
 - a] The applicant shall not dispose of above two wheeler in any manner till disposal of this case.
 - b] The applicant shall produce seized vehicle as and when required as per directions of the Court.
 - c] The applicant shall not use the above vehicle for any criminal activity.
 - d] Issue letter to Saswad police station, Pune, on usual compliance.
