1. Applicant/accused Nitesh Prakashlal Ahuja has filed this application for getting a permission of the Court in respect of obtaining passport for traveling purpose. Learned APP for the State have filed their say and submitted that, if permission granted to applicant/accused for obtaining passport he will abscond and the trial of present matter will be held up. Lastly, prayed for rejection of application.

Accused is ready to secure his presence as and when it is required as per the directions of the Court. Applicant is ready to abide any conditions imposed upon him by the court. Advocate of accused is ready to take further steps according to the law, if any, on his behalf in his absence. Therefore, I have no hesitation to consider this application. In the result, I pass the following order.

- ii. No objection for obtaining passport is granted to applicant/accused **Nitesh Prakashlal Ahuja** on following conditions :-
- iii. Applicant/accused shall not leave the country without seeking prior permission of the Court.
- iv. He shall co-operate in early disposal of the case.
