AWARD

The dispute between the parties having been referred for settlement before the Panel of National Lok-Adalat to be held on 14th March, 2026 and the parties having settled the matter, in view of settlement puris at **Exh. 48** In view of detailed order passed below settlement pursis at **Exh. 48** the following award is passed in terms of the settlement.

1. The claimants are present before the Panel of National Lok-Adalat. They are identified by their learned advocate **Mr. S.C. Jain**. The respondent company is represented by its panel advocate **Mr. D.N. Pingale**. As per authority letter **Exh.49**, respondent Insurance Company has authorized to advocate **Mr. Mr. D.N. Pingale** to enter into compromise.

2. The M.A.C. Petition is settled between claimants and the respondent Insurance Company as per the terms of settlement pursis **Exh. 48** on lump-sum compensation amount of **Rs. 13,00,000/- (Rupees in words Thirteen Lakh only)**

3. The respondent insurance company shall pay the compensation to the petitioners within 30 days, failing which the amount will carry the interest at the rate of 6% p.a.

4. As per the directions of The Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 534/2020 dated 16.03.2021 and the judgment of Hon'ble Madras High Court in Civil Misc. Appeal No.428/2016, the respondent No.3 Insurance Company is hereby directed to deposit the above said awarded amount in the following saving bank account of this Tribunal ;

5. After making such deposit, the insurance company

shall also send a copy of the payment advice in the prescribed format as provided to the Insurance Company, to this Tribunal and also serve its copy on the petitioners.

6. Petitioners to furnish following individual details on separate sheets along with the photocopy of first page of his bank passbook containing photograph of the petitioners and PAN Card, (if any) ;

(i) Full name of the petitioners with current address.

(ii) Name of the Bank & Branch.

(iii) Bank IFSC Code.

(iv) Bank Account Number of petitioners.

7. Petitioners to remain present in person for their personal verification at the time of furnishing the above said information.

8. After deposited afore stated compensation it be apportioned amongst the petitioners Nos. 01 to 05 as follows.
