

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH. 1 IN
CRIMINAL BAIL APPLICATION No.500/2026

(CNR No. MHDH010019572026)

(Raju Yuvraj Gaikwad -v/s- The State of Maharashtra)

(Passed on 17.06.2026)

(1) This is an application filed by accused Raju Yuvraj Gaikwad for bail under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, (for short 'BNSS') in Crime No. 191/2026 registered at Mohadi Nagar Police Station for the offence punishable under Sections 109(1), 189(2), 189(4), 190, 191(2), 193(3), 351(2), 351(3), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNS').

(2) Fact in brief are as under ;

Complainant / informant Mohan More resides with his family at Anwar Nala, Dhule. Prior to the incident, dispute was arisen between the family of complainant and accused Bharat Jadhav and crime was registered. On 20.05.2026 at 5:00 p.m. complainant was seated at Mahadeo temple near agricultural college. One Kisnabai Bhil came there and she made phone to accused Bharat and informed him that informant has sat here. However, informant went towards his house. Informant was inquiring with his brother Kishor and his wife. Accused came there. They were having iron rods, wooden logs and sticks. Accused abused them. Complainant, his brother Kishor, his wife Sunita and son Aryan were convincing the accused Bharat. However, accused Bharat tried to assault on the head of complainant by iron rod, but his nephew Sagar saved the complainant. Accused Bharat assaulted by iron rod on the head and back of Sagar. Accused Lalit Jadhav assaulted by iron rod on the head of Kishor. Accused Gulab Jadhav assaulted by wooden log on the left hand of Aryan. Other accused assaulted to complainant and witnesses by bricks and stones. Accused threatened to kill the complainant. Thereafter, injured were referred to Sai-Seva Hospital. Complainant lodged report against accused.

(3) On the report, crime is registered and the same is under investigation.

(4) Mr. P. R. Sonar, Advocate for accused, submitted that accused is innocent and he has not committed any crime. The counter complaints are registered against both the parties. Accused is arrested on 26.05.2026. The alleged weapons are recovered. Now there is no necessity of the custody of accused. Accused is the only bread earner of his family. Accused is ready to abide by the conditions imposed by the Court. He prayed to release the accused on bail.

(5) Mr. D. Y. Tavar, learned P.P. for the State, submitted that the offence is serious and against the society. If the accused is released on bail, he will commit similar type of offence. He prayed to reject the application.

(6) I have perused the application and say of the prosecution. It is alleged that accused were members of unlawful assembly. They assaulted to the complainant and witnesses by iron rods, sticks, bricks and stones. In the F.I.R., the role assigned to the accused is that he assaulted to witnesses by stick, fists and blows. However, the Muddemal is already recovered. Now there is no recovery and discovery at the instance of accused. Major part of the investigation is completed. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I find that accused is entitled for bail. Therefore, following order :

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail Application No. 500/2026 is hereby allowed.
2. The accused Raju Yuvraj Gaikwad be released on bail on execution of P.B. and S.B. of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) on the conditions that ;

(a) He shall attend the concerned police station as and when called by the Investigating Officer, till filing charge-sheet.

(b) He shall not indulge in similar activities.
