. The matter is on today's board in special drive, which has been organized as per the directions of Hon'ble Registrar (Inspection-I), High Court (Appellate Side) Bombay, Letter No.B(Gen)-1001/2026/223 dated 18.02.2026.

2. This is private complaint filed under **Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act**. The complainant and his Ld. Counsel though repeatedly called out remained absent today. No adjournment application on record. Perused record. It appears that, complaint is filed dated 06.11.2015, whereas, process was issued against accused dated 06.11.2015 by my predecessor and the matter is pending for taking steps against accused since 16.05.2017. Thereafter, report of execution of warrant vide **Exhibit 53**, shows that, accused is expired dated 05.05.2021. So also, complainant failed to proceed further by remaining absent. Matter is 11+ years old, which is stale and ineffective. Moreover, the fact of death of accused is on record. Matter is lingering to secure the presence of accused. However, it will be futile exercise to keep the matter pending on daily board. As per directions of Hon'ble High Court, stale and ineffective cases are directed to be disposed off in special drive, considering the present case, it is 11+ years old and ineffective which is fit case for disposal in special drive u/s 256 of Cr.PC., as per directions of Hon'ble High Court. Hence the following order :-

ORDER

The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution under
Section 256 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
