Shirpur Police Station on 14.02.1996 filed the charge-sheet under Section 394, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. Thereafter, accused remained absent. So may times warrants were issued but could not execute the same. Thereafter, the proclamation under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been issued against the accused. However, despite of issuance of proclamation accused failed to appear. Therefore, I proceed to record the evidence under Section 299 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. On 17.09.2021 two witnesses have been examined. Presence of further witnesses could not be secured, even after issuing sommons. From the record it seems that, the presence of accused in near future could not be secured. Therefore, I am of the opinion that it is just and proper to keep the matter on dormant file. Hence, order as under:

**Order**

Case be kept on dormant file and standing Non-bailable Warrant be issued.
