

ORDER BELOW EXH.01

Perused the application and verification of the complainant. Complainant was verified on 11.03.2022. Thereafter, he remained absent till date. In spite of giving ample opportunities, he failed to appear since then. Since the complainant remained absent and did not proceed with the complaint, this matter is kept for dismissal order by passing order below Exh.1 on 13.01.2026. Thereafter, this matter was listed for dismissal order on 13.01.2026, 09.03.2026.

2. During verification, the complainant did not state about alleged offence. He clearly stated that he was not beaten. The verification of the complainant does not disclose commission of any offence as alleged. Section 203 of CrPC provides that if, after considering the statement on oath of the complainant and of other witnesses, and the result of the inquiry or investigation if any under Section 202 of CrPC, the Magistrate is of opinion that there is no sufficient ground for proceeding, he shall dismiss the complaint.

3. Today the complainant was absent when called out repeatedly. He is absent and there is neither any application for more time on his behalf. The matter is more than **five** years old. Hence, an inference can be drawn that the complainant has lost interest in the present matter and there are no sufficient grounds for proceeding further against the alleged accused. Consequently, following order is passed:-

The complaint is dismissed for want of prosecution vide section 203 of Cr.P.C. and disposed of accordingly.
