**ORDER BELOW EXH.01**

The present application is filed under the provisions of Sections 12, 18, 19, 20, 21 and 22 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. The record shows that from 14.07.2022, the applicant is continuously remained absent. The applicant failed to steps. In spite of giving ample opportunities, she failed to take steps. Therefore, there is no sufficient ground for keeping the application alive on the board. Therefore, the application was kept for dismissal order on 21.06.2025. Thereafter, application was listed on 19.07.2025, 15.10.2025, 13.02.2026 and 25.02.2026 for passing dismissal order.

**02.** Today also the applicant is absent when called out repeatedly. There is no any application for more time on her behalf. The matter is more than **three years** old. Hence, an inference can be drawn that, the applicant has lost her interest in the present application and there is no sufficient ground for proceeding further. Consequently, the following order is passed:-

- 1] The application stands disposed of as dismissed in default.
- 2] No order as to costs.
