Today the plaintiff and defendants are present and duly identified by their learned advocates in National Lokadalat. Parties have voluntarily settled their dispute by mutual consent, reached vide compromise deed at **Exh.20**. Parties have voluntarily admitted the contents & their signatures on pursis and compromise deed at **Exh.19 and 20**. They prayed to draw compromise decree in terms of compromise pursis at **Exh.19**. The contents of pursis **Exh.19** is read over and explained to the parties in presence of their learned advocates and the same is read and recorded. The terms and conditions of compromise pursis seems to be legal and valid. Hence, read and recorded. Accordingly, following order is passed.

: ORDER :

1. The suit is disposed off as compromised in National Lokadalat in terms of compromise pursis and compromised deed at **Exh.19**.
2. The compromise deed at **Exh.19** shall be the part and parcel of compromise decree.
3. The decree passed would be subject to the provisions of Bombay Prevention of Fragmentation and Consolidation of Holdings Act, 1947, if any.
