The instant application is filed by learned counsel for the plaintiff praying therein to grant permission to bring the legal representatives of the plaintiff on record.

2] It is averred that the plaintiff died on 20.12.2025. The names of legally representatives of deceased plaintiff are mentioned in para 3 of the instant application. Ld. counsel for the defendants have not given their say on the instant application. Ld. counsel for the plaintiff prayed to allow the application.

3] Perused the record. It is seen that the suit is for declaration and permanent injunction. The original plaintiff was sole litigating

plaintiff. The application is supported by Death Certificate of deceased plaintiff which shows that plaintiff died on 20.12.2025. The present application is filed on 23.03.2026. Hence, the application is within limitation. As the right to sue survives with the proposed Lrs, for adjudication of matter it is necessary to bring the legal representatives of deceased plaintiff on record. Hence, I pass the following order.

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] The legal representatives of deceased plaintiff be taken on record by carrying out necessary amendment in plaint within a period of 14 days from today and also to supply copy of amendment plaint accordingly.
