ORDER on exhibit D-169

(Delivered on this the 04th day of the month of February of the year 2026).

This order shall dispose of the application filed by the plaintiffs at exhibit D-169 under order 22 Rule 4 of Civil Procedure Code.

2. It is the case of the plaintiff that defendant no. 3 Mrs. Elsa Coelho Costa expired on 11.05.2024 at H.No.26011, Govan, Camorlim, Salcete, Goa without any issues. The plaintiff accordingly prayed that they may be permitted to bracket and show as deleted the name of defendant no. 3 in the cause title. Therefore prayed that the application for bringing legal heirs of defendant no. 3 be allowed and the plaintiffs be permitted to carry out amendment to the cause title accordingly.

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3. Adv. for the defendant No. 1 and 2 endorsed her say on the application stating that the contents and prayer of the application are contradictory. In para 1 of the application it is stated that defendant no. 3 expired without any issues and in the prayer, plaintiffs are craving leave to add the LR's of defendant no.3 and so also to carry out the amendment. Therefore, prayed that the present application be dismissed with heavy cost.

4. Heard arguments on behalf of the advocate for the plaintiff and advocate for defendant no. 1 and 2.

5. Since through this application adv. for plaintiff wishes to bracket the name of defendant no.3 in the cause title and show as deleted as she had expired on 11.05.2024 without any issues and the application was filed on 21.07.2025 and the delay in filing application was condoned. It is not the case of defendants that there are any legal heirs of defendant no.3. The application contents though are not drafted properly.

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6. However, considering the above, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

- a) Application stands allowed to bracket the name of defendant no.3 and to show as expired.
- b) Plaintiff to carry out amendment to cause title within the period of 14 days from the date of this order.
