- 1] Present application filed by defendants for setting aside no W.S. order dated 06.08.2020 and permission to file W.S. on record.
- 2] Said application is strongly opposed by the plaintiff.
- 3] Heard, advocate K. S. Akhade, for defendants and advocate K. T. Munghate, for plaintiff.
- 4] According to defendant, he served summons on 11.07.2020 but in that period Covid-19 pandemic disease was continuously spreading and due to lock-down defendants could not attend Court. Reasons stated by defendants are satisfactory. In August 2020 many parties did not attend Court and also Hon'ble High Court directed not to pass any adverse order against party who failed to attend court. Hence, application is tenable. Hence, following order.

- 2] No W.S. order dated 06.08.2020 is hereby set aside and permission granted to defendants to file W.S. on record.
