ORDER BELOW EXH. 20
(Passed on 10.04.2026)

1. By way of present application under Section 483 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Surkasha Sanhita, the accused is seeking regular bail.
2. Perused the application and say of Additional Public Prosecutor. Heard learned advocate for the accused and learned Additional Public Prosecutor.
3. The accused was released on bail earlier. It appears that the accused was out of town for labour work and therefore he could not appear before the court because of which non-bailable warrant was issued and he was arrested. Learned advocate for the accused submitted that hereinafter he will appear before the court regularly. I am of the view that one more opportunity deserves to be granted to the accused. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application (Exhibit No.20) is allowed.
2. Accused Mallesh Banayya Yeladi, be released on bail on execution of PR bond of Rs.50,000/- (Rs.Fifty Thousand only) and one surety in like amount in connection with Crime No.302/2021 registered with Police Station, Aheri for offences punishable under Sections 363, 376 of the Indian Penal Code read with Section 4, 8 and 12 of the Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act, on following conditions :
 - a) accused person shall not influence prosecution witnesses.
 - b) accused person shall not tamper with prosecution evidence.
 - c) accused person shall remain present before the Court on every date. In exceptional circumstances, he can apply for personal exemption.
 - d) accused person shall furnish his mobile number and address proof.
 - e) accused person shall furnish mobile numbers and address proof of his two close relatives.
