1. The claim petition is fixed for final arguments.
2. The evidence of Non-Applicant No.3 – Insurance Company was earlier closed on 17/12/2025 below Exh.1, as no evidence was led despite opportunity.
3. The present application is filed by Non-Applicant No.3 seeking issuance of summons to the R.T.O. for examination and production of relevant record.
4. Learned Advocate for the applicant/claimant has filed say and has submitted that, he has no objection if the application is allowed.
5. Considering the nature of proceedings under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, which are summary in nature,

and in order to afford reasonable opportunity to the Insurance Company to substantiate its defence, I am of the opinion that one last opportunity deserves to be granted in the interest of justice.

6. Since the claimant has no objection and as the proposed evidence relates to official record, which may assist the Court in arriving at just decision, the application can be allowed subject to terms. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

ORDER

2. Issue summons to the concerned R.T.O. for production of relevant record and examination on P.F.
