ORDER BELOW EXH.47
(Passed on 05.01.2026)

By the present application Exh.47, the claimants prayed for exhibiting documents filed below list Exh.4 at serial Nos.14, 15, 15(1), 15(2) and filed below list Exh.26 at serial No.1.

2. The application is strongly opposed by the respondents contending that there is no substance in the application. There are no reasons and therefore, the documents cannot be exhibited and prayed to reject the application.

3. Heard learned advocate Smt.D.G. Doye for the claimants and learned advocate Shri. P .M. Nichkawade for respondents. Perused the application along with the submissions and record of the case.

4. Considering the nature of the petition which is benevolent litigation, the proposed documents to be exhibited are the driving license of the deceased, Aadhaar Card of

claimant No.1, Aadhaar Cards of claimant Nos.4 & 5 and below list Exh.26 serial No.1 is the document which is leaving certificate of the college of the deceased Kuldip Narware. These documents show that document No.1 is the photocopy of the license of the deceased. If at all breach or negligence of deceased is to be established, it is for the defence by the respondents who can do so by examining the witness, if at all necessary. Therefore, exhibiting these documents will not be causing any serious prejudice to the respondents. The Aadhaar card documents are produced solely for the purpose of identifying the claimants and are issued by the Government, hence, they are accepted on record and may be exhibited. Last but not least. The school leaving certificate is a document of the deceased issued by the school. There is no reason to refuse to accept it on record. The only objection is that the aforesaid reason is not mentioned in the application. Merely because, at the time of filing, the claimants could not produce the said documents, or the learned advocate could not procure them, the claim will not be affected. Even otherwise, claim can be decided on the basis of the documents received under DAR, which is the duty of the Police Station Officer.

5. In view of above, the objection is rejected and application is allowed. The documents are respectively

marked at Exhibits 48, 49, 50 and 51. In above term, application is allowed and disposed of.
