**Order below Exh. No. 01 In Civil M.A. No. 133/2025,
Meera Pawar and others Vs. Nil
(Passed On:- 23/03/2026)**

This is an application filed by applicants under provisions of the Section 2 and 8 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 for the issuance of Legal Heir-ship Certificate in their name for purpose of their recognition as Legal heirs of deceased namely who **Sachin S/o Kishanrao Pawar died on 21/06/2025 at Parbhani, Tq. & Dist. Parbhani**, leaving behind the deceased only applicants are the legal heirs. The applicants submitted that, applicant no. 1 is wife of deceased, applicant no. 2 and 3 are daughters of deceased and applicant no.4 is mother of deceased. The applicants are only legal heirs of deceased. The applicants submitted that they have required heirship certificate for the purpose of government and semi government purpose therefore they prayed for legal heirship certificate in the name of **Sachin S/o Kishanrao Pawar**.

02. Heard the Ld. advocate of applicants. In accordance with order exh. 1, paper publication was directed and after publication of notice in daily newspaper “**Gaonwala**” dated 10/02/2026 the objections were invited. However, no one has appeared and raised any objection for issuance of legal heir-ship certificate. Nobody is objected as respondent/opponent. In support of their claim the applicant no. 1 has filed affidavit in lieu of examination in chief below exhibit 10 & 17, and reproducing contents from main application and in which on oath she deposed that, applicant no. 1 is wife of deceased and applicants no. 2 and 3 are daughters of deceased and applicant no.4 is mother of deceased. The applicant deposed that, except these applicants deceased have no other legal heirs.

03. In regard to documentary evidence applicants have produced on record Copy of paper publication, verified Copy of Aadhar Card of applicants and

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copy of death certificate in name of **Sachin S/o Kishanrao Pawar**. Applicants have filed pursis below **Exh. 18** for closing their evidence.

04. Thus, on perusal of record it indicates that, in spite of publication of paper notice no one has appeared and raised any objection for issuance of Legal Heir-ship certificate. There is no reason to disbelieve on affidavit and documents produced on record. On perusal of death certificate of deceased namely **Sachin S/o Kishanrao Pawar**, it shows that permanent residential address of deceased is at Laxman Tanda, Tq. Aundha (N), Dist. Hingoli. Accordingly this court have jurisdiction to entertain present Civil M.A. application. Moreover, the records seems that applicants are the class I heirs of the deceased. Therefore, they are entitled for heirship certificate. The heirship certificate does not confer any rights in applicants regarding the property of the deceased except the formal legal recognition as heirs of deceased. In the result, following order is passed.

--: ORDER :-

1.	The application (Exh.1) is allowed.
2.	Issue Legal Heir-ship certificate in name of applicant Nos. 1 to 4 formally recognizing them as Legal Heirs of the deceased namely Sachin S/o Kishanrao Pawar on payment of requisite court fees if required any.
3.	In case of use of this certificate for any other immovable property, applicants are directed to inform this court and to pay requisite court fees.
