**AD-INTERIM ORDER BELOW EXH. 9**

( Passed on 11.03.2026 )

01. By this application, the applicant is seeking ad-interim relief.

02. The applicant has filed this application for grant of ad-interim relief. It is the contention of applicant that the notices and the order passed by the opponent be stayed till filing of reply. It is further contention of the applicant that, order passed under section 45A and 45G are ex-parte orders. The opportunity was not given to him. His bank account is illegally ceased by the opponents. As such stay may be granted and defreeze his account.

03. The opponent filed his say and strongly objected for stay the order passed by the opponents. He denied all the averments made by the applicant and strongly opposed to grant the application.

04. Heard both the parties. Perused the say. The applicant is challenging the legality of an order passed by him under section 45A dated 17.03.2025 and under section 45G dated 25.02.2026 and defreezing his bank account. It is contention of the applicant that the period mentioned by the opponents for determined the contribution amount is the period of Covid-19. No employee was working and his

company was totally closed. It is also contention of the applicant that no notice was served against him and the opponent has passed the ex-parte order against him. Hence, under such circumstances, it will be proper to pass ad-interim relief in favour of the applicant as below.

**ORDER**

1. The order passed by the opponents under section 45A dated 17.03.2025 and order passed under section 45G dated 25.02.2026 are stayed till next date.
2. The bank account of the applicant is defreezed till further order.
3. The opponents are directed not to take coercive action against applicant till next date.
