**Resumed on S.A.**

**Further cross-examination by Advocate Shri Bhagwat for the Respondent:**

29. The documents at pages No. 51 to 77 of Exh.C-32 pertain to the expenditure of the company. Said pages no. 51 to 77 bear my signatures. So these documents are collectively exhibited as **Exh.C-33**. Now I am shown pages no.79, 82 and 83 of Exh.C-32. These documents don't bear my signature. I do not know whose signature is appearing on pages no.79, 82 & 83. I do not know whether the company gives a no due certificate in favour of the subcontractor while making final payment. I do not know whether page no.86 of Exh.C-32 is signed by my then colleague Mr. Prashant Tripathi.

30. I cannot say whether the subcontractor submits bill to the respondent company for making payment. I was doing service for the respondent company in Algeria for near about 2 years. It is not true to say that, while working in Algeria, verifying bills submitted by subcontractors was one of my duties. I cannot say whether the ledger statement at pages no. 87 & 88 of Exh.C-32 was signed by Mr. Prashant Tripathi. Pages no.93, 95, 99 & 100 of Exh.C-32 were not written or signed by me.
