Heard learned Advocates for both the parties. Perused the record.

2. Being aggrieved by Judgment and order dated 6.1.2026 passed by the learned Labour Court in Complaint (ULP) No. 6/2023, this revision application is filed. From the record and proceedings of said complaint, it appears that on the date of said Judgment and order, the complainant filed application at Exh. U-93 seeking extension for execution of said Judgment and stay to the impugned show cause notice for one month. It appears that the learned Labour Court granted extension for one month. It appears that in view thereof the complainant is still in employment. This fact is not disputed by the respondent. In such facts and circumstances, both parties pressed for final hearing on this revision application. Accordingly, today the learned Advocates for both the parties advanced arguments. The learned Advocate for the applicant wants to file some authorities and wants to advance reply argument on next date. It appears that arguments are likely to be completed on next date. Therefore, this Court is of the view that the protection granted to complainant by the Labour Court vide order below Exh.U-93 is required to be continued till next date. Accordingly, the respondent to maintain status-quo as regard service of applicant till next date. Parties to take note.
