Read complaint, application in the light of documents available on record. Heard learned Advocate for the complainant.

2] It is submitted that, for the post of Aasha Swayamsevika, complainant and respondent no.4 undergone recruitment procedure of respondent no.1 to 3. During recruitment procedure, complainant secured 13 marks out of 15 and respondent no.4 secured only 11 marks. Despite of that, by following illegal procedure, respondents are bent upon to select and appoint respondent no.4. Complainant by way of this

application sought relief to stay further recruitment process i.e. issuance of appointment letter to respondent no.4.

3] The learned Advocate for the complainant fairly conceded before Court on the information gathered from Advocate for respondent no.3 and 4 that the appointment letter has already been issued in favour of respondent no.4.

4] In view of the submissions made at bar, I pass following order.

ORDER

- i] Issue show cause notice to respondents as to why interim injunction sought for should not be granted in favour of complainant.
- ii] Notice returnable on 22.09.2023.
