

Regular Civil Appeal No.34 of 2019

(Manohar Bhandarkar Vs.1. Ganesh Gupta and Ors.3)

1. By this application, the heirs and legal representatives of deceased appellant Manohar Bhikaji Bhandarkar are seeking permission to bring them on record.
2. The A.G.P for respondent Nos. 2 to 4 submitted his say overleaf. He submitted to pass the necessary order.
3. Heard the Ld. Advocates for both the parties.
4. The application is supported with affidavit of Hemant Manohar Bhandarkar at Exh.19. His affidavit reveals that the appellant Manohar Bhikaji Bhandarkar died on 09.12.2024 leaving behind a widow and three sons as his only heirs. The death certificate of the appellant is also placed on record. It seems that the right to sue survives in favour of the heirs and legal representatives of deceased appellant. The application is within limitation. Hence I pass the following order.

Order

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) The heirs and legal representatives of deceased appellant are allowed to be taken on record. The appellants to carry out necessary amendment in the title clause of the appeal memo within 14 days from the date of order.
- 3) No order as to costs.
