1] Claimant is minor. Petition is filed by father of claimant. Father of claimant present along with his advocate and learned advocate / representative for respondent No.2 insurance company are present before the Tribunal. By application below Exh.19 supporting affidavit at Exh.20 and certificate at Exh.21 permission is sought to enter into compromise on behalf of minor / claimant. Permission is granted. Both sides filed compromise pursis at Exh.23. Wherein both sides agreed that the insurance company shall pay Rs.25,000/- to the claimant as full and final payment within two months.

2] Since, the claim is settled amicably between the parties, the parties shall be governed by the terms of settlement. If the claim amount is not deposited within stipulated period, the respondent No.2 insurance company shall pay the interest at the rate of 7% P.A. Claim against respondent No.1 is disposed off. Claimant to deposit the deficit Court Fee Stamp, if any, in the Court. Hence, following order.

ORDER

1. In the terms of compromise pursis below Exh.23 petition stands disposed off.
2. The compromise pursis at Ex.23 be treated as part and parcel of the award.
3. The claimant is entitled to recover compensation of

Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand only) from respondent No.2.

4. The claimant being minor the compensation amount be kept in fixed deposit in any nationalized bank till he attains majority.
5. The claim against respondent No.1 stands disposed off as withdrawn.
6. The claimant shall deposit deficit court fees if any, within 15 days from the date of this order.
7. Award be drawn up accordingly.
