264 of 2022 State Vs. Kuldeep Singh.

Present: APP for the State.
Accused absent.

Non-bailable warrants of arrest issued against accused received back unexecuted. Perusal of record reveals that this case is pending since long for service of accused and process issued to him has been received back with one or another report. This Court is satisfied that accused is concealing his presence and is absconding and cannot be served in ordinary process. As such, in order to avoid any further delay, time and energy, this Court finds it proper to procure presence of accused through proclamation Under Section 82 of Cr.P.C. Let proclamation Under Section 82 of Cr.P.C be issued against the accused in writing requiring him to appear within 30 days from the date on which the proclamation is effected against him. As such, accused Kuldeep Singh is ordered to be served through proclamation under Section 82 Cr. P. C. for 04.11.2023.

Summons to surety, namely, Sahib Singh received back duly served. Despite service of notice surety, namely, Sahib Singh has not come present. This Court has reason to believe that presence of surety cannot be procured through ordinary manner. Let presence of surety, namely, Sahib Singh be procured by issuance of non-bailable warrants of arrest for recording his testimony for date fixed.
