**ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Delivered on : 15.04.2026)**

The applicant/accused has preferred this bail application under the provisions of section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNSS” for the sake of brevity), seeking bail in Crime No.53/2026 registered with Bhokardan police station under Sections 76, 118(1), 115(2), 119(1), 333, 352, 351(2), 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNS” for the sake of brevity).

02. As per the applicant/accused, the 19 years old victim lodged complaint on 12.02.2026 contending that on 06.2.2026 at around 1.30p.m. when she was alone at the house, the applicant/accused under influence of liquor, entered her house and started speaking obscene to her. Victim asked him to leave the house, but he started abusing her. He pushed her on the ground and touched

her inappropriately. Hearing her screams, the neighbours gathered, her mother and brother also came. The applicant/accused assaulted his brother and mother and snatched the gold ornaments of her mother. Later, when the father of victim went to confront him, he also assaulted him with wooden stick and threatened him. Hence, complaint was filed.

03. As per the applicant/accused, he is falsely implicated in the offence. He was arrested on 16.02.2026 and since 17.02.2026, he is in Judicial custody. The applicant/accused contends that there is delay of 6 days in filing complaint which is unexplained. The complaint is filed due to previous enmity. Nothing is to be recovered. The applicant/accused is working as a labourer and sole earner of the family. The applicant/accused is ready to abide with terms and conditions of bail, if imposed on him.

04. The prosecution resisted the bail application by filing say at Exh.04. It is contended that the offence is serious in nature. It is further contended that, the applicant/accused outraged the modesty of the victim, assaulted by stick, abused and threatened the informant and the witnesses. He also snatched the gold necklace of the witness. The investigation is in progress. The prosecution apprehends that in case the applicant/accused is released on bail, he will tamper the evidence and threaten the witnesses. Hence, the application is sought to be rejected.

05. The victim appeared and filed her no objection vide Exh.5 to grant the bail to the applicant/accused.

06. Heard learned Counsel Shri.S.L.Gaikwad for the applicant/accused and the learned In-charge D.G.P. Shri.B.V.Ingle for the State. Perused the papers submitted by the prosecution.

07. From the reply of prosecution and police papers, it is seen that the admittedly since 17.02.2026, the applicant/accused is in judicial custody. Nothing is shown to be recovered or discovered from the hands of this applicant/accused, for which, his custodial interrogation would be required. It is seen that in her supplementary statement the victim has stated that the applicant/accused was in intoxicated state outside of her house. He has not snatched the gold ornaments of her mother. He just abused and was taken by his wife. However, she has filed complaint due to anger over him. Hence, it is seen that the victim has therefore no objection to release the applicant/accused on bail. The apprehension of the prosecution can be taken care of by imposing stringent conditions on the applicant/accused. Hence, the applicant/accused is entitled to be released on bail. With this, I pass the following order: -

ORDER

1. Bail Application No.129 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
2. The applicant/accused **Karbhari s/o Damodhar Bakal** be released on executing P. R. Bond of Rs.15,000/-(Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) with surety of like amount, in C.R.No.53 of 2026 registered with Bhokardan Police Station, on following conditions:-
 - a. The accused shall not tamper, threaten or influence the victim and/or complainant and witnesses and/or directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer or tamper with the evidence of prosecution.

- b. Accused shall not commit similar offence of which he is accused.
 - c. Accused shall furnish his address, contact details & Aadhaar Card alongwith contact numbers and addresses of two acquainted persons.
 - d. Accused shall not leave the jurisdiction of District Jalna, till final disposal of the case.
3. Violation of any of the condition imposed shall amount to cancellation of bail forthwith.
 4. Authenticated copy of this order be sent to the accused through the Jailor.
 5. A soft copy of this order be sent by e-mail to the prisoner through the Jail Superintendent, Jalna.
 6. Bail Application No.129 of 2026 stands disposed off accordingly.
