ORDER BELOW EXH.1

(Delivered on : 15.04.2026)

The applicants/accused have preferred application under the provision of Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNSS” for the sake of brevity), apprehending arrest in Crime No.76/2026 registered with Badnapur police station under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 119(1), 189(2), 190, 191(2), 191(3), 324(2), 351(3), 352 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNS” for the sake of brevity).

02. As per the applicants/accused, one Jaker Shaikh lodged complaint on 24.02.2026, being admitted at Civil Hospital, Jalna that, he is residing at Badnapur. The son of his brother had expired and his daughter-in-law had filed case at Badnapur. On 23.02.2026, he along

with Anwar Shaikh, Sajid Shaikh, Wajid Shaikh, Soheli Shaikh, Arbaz Shaikh and Shehnaz Shaikh went to Civil Court Badnapur, where Tasleem Shaikh and her relative also came. After attending date, when they were returning in their Creta car, the applicant/accused No.3 blocked their car with his Eco car. The applicants/accused got down from the vehicle started abusing and assaulting them. The applicant/accused No.3 assaulted with knife, the applicants/accused No.1 and 7 with wooden sticks. They also snatched cash and mobile phone and damaged the vehicle. Hence, the complaint was filed.

03. As per the applicants/accused, they are falsely implicated in the offence. The contentions of the complaint are vague. Nothing is to be recovered at the hands of these applicants/accused. The applicants/accused are permanent residents of given address. They are ready to abide by the terms and conditions of bail if imposed on them.

04. The prosecution resisted the application by filing say at Exh.07. It is contended that the offence is serious in nature. The applicants/accused assaulted informant and witnesses with knife, stick, kicks and blows. They also snatched cash and mobile phone and damaged the vehicle. The investigation is in progress. Muddled articles are to be recovered. The prosecution apprehends that in case the applicants/accused are released on bail, they will tamper the evidence and threaten the witnesses. Hence, the application is sought to be rejected.

05. Heard learned advocate Shri.Sayyed Tariq for the applicants/accused and the learned In-charge D.G.P. Shri.B.V.Ingle for the State. Perused the copy FIR and papers submitted by the prosecution.

06. The learned advocate for the applicants/accused submitted that, to counter their complaint, the informant has filed false complaint. Previously also, there were complaints, which were made to the Superintendent of Police at Jalna.

07. From the reply of prosecution and police papers, it is seen that the informant and witnesses had suffered the injuries. However, now they are discharged. The weapons used, mobile phone and cash are yet to be recovered. Therefore, the custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused is required. Hence, considering the allegations against the applicants/accused, the nature of the offence, I do not find the applicants/accused entitled for the relief of anticipatory bail. Hence, I pass the following order: -

ORDER

- 1) Criminal Bail Application No.161/2026 is rejected.
- 2) Criminal Bail Application No.161 of 2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
