ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Delivered on : 15.04.2026)

The applicants/accused have preferred application under the provision of Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNSS” for the sake of brevity), apprehending arrest in Crime No.75/2026 registered with Badnapur police station under Sections 118(1), 119(1), 324(2), 115(2), 352, 351(3), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNS” for the sake of brevity).

02. As per the applicants/accused, injured Ajim Sayyed lodged complaint on 24.02.2026 being admitted in Ojas Hospital, Jalna, contending that he is residing at Manmad. The sister of his brother-in-

law was residing at Badnapur and her husband is expired. There is litigation pending between her and her in-laws. On 23.02.2026, there was Court date at Badnapur and therefore, he along with Tasleem Shaikh, Rukhsar Shaikh, Saniya Shaikh, Alim Shaikh, Husen Shaikh and their advocate Naser Pathan in Badnapur Court. After attending the date at around 3.30p.m., they started for Manmad in their Eco Car. At around 4.50pm when they were taking turn, the applicant/accused No.1 stopped them. The applicant/accused No.2 started assaulting Tasleem Shaikh and Husen Shaikh. Informant started the vehicle but one Creta car came and blocked him. The applicants/accused No.3, 4 and other persons came out from the vehicle with knife and sticks. Another vehicle blocked the car from behind. The applicants/accused No.5 and 6 came out from the vehicle with sword, wooden sticks and knife. They assaulted informant, Rukhsar Shaikh, Saniya Shaikh, Alim Shaikh, Hussain Shaikh and advocate Pathan. They threatened to kill them and took away gold chain and necklace from Tasleem Shaikh and Rukhsar Shaikh. They also snatched mobile phone of Husen. Hence, the complaint was filed.

03. As per the applicants/accused, they are falsely implicated in the offence. The son of applicant/accused No.1 and husband of Tasleem Shaikh died on 17.07.2024 and she started demanding his share, over which, there were quarrels. Within a month of her husband's death, Tasleem left with her son to her parental house. On 10.12.2024, Tasleem went to her matrimonial house with Aslam Shehejad and Shaikh Ali. They assaulted applicant/accused No.4. Therefore, complaint was filed, which is registered as crime No.498 of 2024 at Badnapur police station. After the death of son of applicant/accused No.1, they suspected that Tasleem and her relatives have given some medicine, due to which, he expired and therefore,

they filed complaint on 21.04.2025 with Badnapur police station and a private complaint Miscr.Cri. Appln No.83 of 2025 came to be registered. The applicants/accused have also filed civil suit against Tasleem. On 20.12.2025, the applicants/accused No.1 has filed complaint against Tasleem and her relatives, which is registered as crime No.830 of 2025 and Miscr. Criminal Appln No.02 of 2024, which is also pending.

04. As per the applicants/accused, on 23.02.2026, they were at Badnapur Court for attending the Court, but Tasleem came along with five to six persons. They obstructed the applicants/accused and assaulted them with wooden sticks and knife. They also snatched mobile phone and cash from applicants/accused, therefore crime No.76 of 2026 is filed against the informant and others. The contents of the complaint are vague in nature. Section 119(1) of BNS is not applicable. There is nothing to be recovered at the hands of these applicants/accused. The applicants/accused belong to one family. They are permanent residents of Badnapur. They are ready to abide by the terms and conditions of bail if imposed on them.

05. The prosecution resisted the application by filing say at Exh.07. It is contended that the offence is serious in nature. The applicants/accused and co-accused assaulted informant and witnesses by sword, knife, stick, kicks and blows. They snatched mobile and gold ornaments of witnesses and damaged the vehicle of the informant. The investigation is in progress. Muddemal articles are to be recovered. The prosecution apprehends that in case the applicants/accused are released on bail, they will tamper the evidence and threaten the witnesses. Hence, the application is sought to be rejected.

06. Heard learned advocate Shri.Sayyed Mujib for the applicants/accused and the learned A.PP. Smt.J.B.Solanke for the State. Perused the copy FIR and papers submitted by the prosecution.

07. The learned advocate for the applicants/accused submitted that, there was no reason for the relatives of Tasleem to accompany her which shows that they intended to assault the applicants/accused. He also submitted that, the injured are discharged from the hospital.

08. From the reply of prosecution and police papers, it is seen that the informant and witnesses had suffered the injuries. However, now they are discharged. The weapons used, mobile phone and gold ornaments are yet to be recovered. Therefore, the custodial interrogation of the applicants/accused is required. Hence, considering the allegations against the applicants/accused, the nature of the offence, I do not find the applicants/accused entitled for the relief of anticipatory bail. Hence, I pass the following order: -

ORDER

- 1) Criminal Bail Application No.162 of 2026 is rejected.
- 2) Criminal Bail Application No.162 of 2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
