**ORDER BELOW EXH.1**

(Delivered on : 13.05.2026)

. The applicant/accused has preferred application under the provision of Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNSS” for the sake of brevity), apprehending arrest in Crime No.56/2026 registered with Jafrabad police station under Section 336(1), 335, 336(2), 336(3), 337, 340(2), 318(4), 212, 217, 308(1), 308(2), 61(2), 356(2), 318(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNS” for the sake of brevity).

02. As per the applicant/accused, one Deepak Wakade lodged complaint on 25.02.2026 contending that he is owner and possessor of Survey No.43 and Gat No.62 admeasuring 32 Acres 22 Gunthas at Jafrabad, which was purchased by his grand-mother in 1952. Out of the said land, at present informant is owner and possessor of 1 H 92 R

land. The applicant/accused has given a letter to Divisional Collector, Chhatrapati Sambhaji Nagar on 15.09.2025 contending that the land of informant is evacuee land and it is being sold illegally with the help of Tahsildar Jafrabad. The applicant/accused forged the said letter has been sent by the Government of India on 07.01.1979. Said letter was computerized, which shows that it was forged. The copy of said letter was also sent to Tahsildar Jafrabad. The letter does not bear any signature of any competent officer of seal of the office. The applicant/accused also blackmailed the informant and demanded Rs.50,00,000/- from him. Hence, complaint is filed.

03. As per the applicant/accused, he is falsely implicated in the offence. The allegations levelled against him are vague in nature. The complaint is intentionally filed after the delay. The complaint is based on documentary evidence. Therefore, there is no necessity of his judicial custody. Since survey No.43 Gat No.62 is evacuee land, the litigation is pending before Hon'ble High Court. The applicant/accused has filed petition before Hon'ble High Court about illegal land being sold of Gat NO.62 in which, various inquiries have been conducted and fearing it, informant has filed this false complaint. The applicant/accused is respectable person and permanent resident of given address. The applicant/accused contends that he is ready to abide with terms and conditions of bail, if imposed on him.

04. The prosecution resisted the application by filing say at Exh.6. It is contended that the offence is serious in nature. The applicant/accused and co-accused are involved in serious conspiracy to cheat and defraud informant and Government in systematic manner. The applicant/accused has cheated the informant and Government by fabricating the documents and demanded Rs.50,00,000/- as extortion

amount. The investigation is in progress. Muddemal is yet to be recovered. As per the prosecution, in case applicant/accused is released on bail, he will abscond or threaten the witnesses. Hence, application is sought to be rejected.

05. The informant resisted the bail application by filing say vide Exh.11. He reiterated all the contents of his complaint. He further contended that, the applicant/accused has filed false application to cause loss of the informant for non payment of extortion amount. There are criminal antecedents of the applicant/accused and four cases are pending against him. Hence, application is sought to be rejected.

06. Heard learned advocate Shri.M.S.Raut for the applicant/accused, the learned In-charge D.G.P. Shri.B.V. Ingle for the State and the learned advocate Shri.V.S.Deshpande for the informant. Perused the copy of FIR and police papers submitted by the prosecution.

07. The learned Counsel for the applicant/accused submitted that civil suits were pending between the grand-mother of the informant and Government. He has relied on the copies of information received from Divisional Collector, Aurangabad, allotment order, letter of Government of India, letter of Collector Jalna, copy of Spl. Civil Suit NO.25 of 2018 and written statement filed in it, whereas the informant has filed copy of SDM Bhokardan dated 15.04.2026.

08. The learned advocate for the applicant/accused further submits that there are many cases filed against him since he has reported many cases of soil theft to the Superintendent of Police.

09. The learned advocate for the intervener submitted that inquiries are initiated and the Writ Petition No.1718 of 1991 was allowed. It is also submitted that the applicant/accused has not complied with the directions issued in the case of **Zeba Khan Vs. State of UP in Criminal Appeal No.825 of 2026** by not disclosing his criminal antecedents.

10. From the reply of the prosecution and police papers it is seen that as per the allegations made in the complaint, applicant/accused has used forged stamps and documents, which are to be recovered. The investigation is in progress. Considering the nature of the offence, custodial interrogation of the applicant/accused is necessary. Hence, I pass the following order: -

**ORDER**

- 1) Criminal Bail Application No.166 of 2026 is rejected.
- 2) Criminal Bail Application No.166 of 2026 stands disposed of accordingly.
