ORDER BELOW EXH.1
(Delivered on : 07.07.2026)

The applicant/accused has preferred this bail application under the provisions of section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNSS” for the sake of brevity), seeking bail in Crime No.439/2024 registered with Takula Jalna police station under Sections 103(1), 238 r/w 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as the “BNS” for the sake of brevity).

02. As per the applicant/accused, the informant Rameshwar Raosaheb Gaikwad lodged complaint on 07/07/2024 contending that in the morning hours 7.00 a.m. his mother came to him and told that people were whispering that someone committed murder of his brother Laxman and body was thrown at Rajputwadi shiwar (farm land). Therefore immediately he and his mother on his motorcycle

went to Rajputwadi shiwar. It is further contended in the report that on reaching there, they saw Laxman was lying as dead. There were blood stains on his fingers and jacket. He opened the jacket. His singlet was in pool of blood. He also noticed stab marks on chest and ribs with sharp weapon. The informant inquired with mother, at that time his mother informed him that on previous day in night at about 9.00 to 10.00 p.m. deceased Laxman received call of someone and thereafter he went and never returned. Hence, the informant lodged the report against unknown person.

03. As per the applicant/accused, he is falsely implicated in the offence. He was arrested on 08.05.2026 and since 08.05.2026, he is in Judicial custody. The FIR is lodged against unknown person. The informant reached on the spot after the incident. No motive is disclosed against present applicant/accused in the FIR. The main accused is already acquitted after full fledged trial. He is the sole earner of the family. The investigation is already completed. The applicant/accused is ready to abide with terms and conditions of bail, if imposed on him.

04. The prosecution resisted the bail application by filing say at Exh.04. It is contended that the offence is serious in nature. It is further contended that, the applicant/accused along with co-accused committed brutal murder of the deceased Laxman. The accusation against present applicant/accused is grave and serious. The prosecution apprehends that in case the applicant/accused is released on bail, he will tamper the evidence and threaten the witnesses. Hence, the application is sought to be rejected.

05. Heard learned Counsel Shri.A.S.Raut for the applicant/accused and the learned In-charge D.G.P. Shri.B.V.Ingle for the State. Perused the papers submitted by the prosecution.

06. The learned advocate for the applicant/accused submitted that, no specific role of present applicant/accused is attributed. The main accused is already acquitted. Investigation is completed and charge-sheet is also filed against applicant/accused.

07. From the reply of prosecution and police papers, it is seen that the admittedly, since 08.05.2026, the applicant/accused is in Judicial custody. The trial of the co-accused was separated and completed. Nothing is shown to be recovered or discovered at the hands of this applicant/accused, for which, his further custodial interrogation would be required. The apprehension of the prosecution can be taken care of by imposing stringent conditions on the applicant/accused. Hence, the applicant/accused is entitled to be released on bail. With this, I pass the following order: -

ORDER

1. Bail Application No.452 of 2026 is hereby allowed.
2. The applicant/accused **Jagdish Dnyaneshwar Mule** be released on executing P. R. Bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-five Thousand only) with surety of like amount, in C.R.No.439 of 2024 registered with Taluka Jalna Police Station, on following conditions:-
 - a. The accused shall not tamper, threaten or influence the victim and/or complainant and witnesses and/or directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any

person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or any Police Officer or tamper with the evidence of prosecution.

- b. Accused shall not commit similar offence of which he is accused.
 - c. Accused shall furnish his address, contact details & Aadhaar Card alongwith contact numbers and addresses of two acquainted persons.
 - d. Accused shall not leave the jurisdiction of District Jalna, till final disposal of the case.
- 3. Violation of any of the condition imposed shall amount to cancellation of bail forthwith.
 - 4. Authenticated copy of this order be sent to the accused through the Jailor.
 - 5. A soft copy of this order be sent by e-mail to the prisoner through the Jail Superintendent, Jalna.
 - 6. Bail Application No.452 of 2026 stands disposed off accordingly.
