ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.1

1. On the previous date the Accused No.1 was directed for the medical examination by the Government Hospital for his mental illness. The report is received from the Indira Gandhi Government Medical College and Hospital, Nagpur under the signatures of Assistant Professor and Associate Professor, Department of Psychiatric and which is submitted by the Prosecution by way of purshis at Exh.113. As per the said medical report the following are the findings in respect of Accused Praful Bhagwan Mahamuni.

1. Conscious, unco-operative, Inappropriate restricted affect aud.

Hall. no I/J, and

2. Inappropriate, restricted affect no insight derailment.

The diagnosis column of the said report describes the ailment as 'chronic schizophrenia'.

2. In view of the aforesaid ailment, the trial needs to be postponed in view of the provisions of Section 329 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The Accused shall continue his medical treatment and he be again medically examined by the doctors of Psychiatric Department, Indira Gandhi Government Medical College

and Hospital, Nagpur and the report be submitted in this case.
