**ORDER BELOW EXH.12 IN M.A.C.P. NO.169/2019**

[ Sharda & oths. V/s. Bhagwat and oths. ]

1. Perused the application. Heard, learned Advocate for the claimant. It seems that one Vilas Rathod died accidental death in motor vehicle accident, therefore his legal heirs filed claim petition for grant of compensation. When a summons was issued to the respondent no.1 i.e. owner of the offending vehicle, Bailiff sent a report contending that he died. Hence, this application is to bring his legal heir on record. Claimants contended that deceased respondent no.1 left behind a son Mahesh Bhagwat Chaudhary, therefore he should be brought on record.

2. Notice was issued to the proposed L.R's. In spite of the service of notice by registered post, he failed to appear. Perusal of the Bailiff report shows that respondent no.1 died on 26/12/2021, while present application came to be filed on

17/07/2020. Claimants came to know about the death of the respondent no.1 through the Bailiff report and as soon as received the Bailiff report, they had filed this petition for bringing L.R's on record, therefore, delay in bringing the L.R's on record is hereby condoned and claimants are permitted to bring Mahesh Bhagwat Chaudhary on record as a legal heir of the deceased respondent no.1. Claimants are directed to carry out the amendment within the stipulated period and file amended claim petition along with a copies so as to serve it on the legal heirs of the deceased respondent no.1. No order as to the costs.
