Read the application and affidavit in support of it. Heard the learned advocate Shri. B. V. Naik for the plaintiff. Perused the record. The present suit is taken on board by the plaintiff for seeking ad-interim temporary injunction. According to the plaintiff, the defendants are completing the construction of the disputed highway under the police protection on 30.11.2023. The water flowing from the east side causes damage to the plaintiff's crop and agriculture produce. It is necessary to restrain the defendants from completing the construction of disputed highway. Therefore, the present application is filed.

2. I have gone through the record. Accordingly, the defendant No.6 appeared in the suit through advocate. The defendant No.7 is not served with the suit summons and notice of temporary injunction application. The defendant No.8 sought time to appear through advocate. In the circumstances, the plaintiff prayed for ad-interim injunction against the defendant No.6 to 8.

3. Having regard to the contention raised in the application, no case made out by the plaintiff to grant ad-interim temporary injunction against the defendant No.6 to 8 as prayed. Hence, issue notice/s to the defendant No.6 to 8 to show cause as to why ad-interim temporary injunction as prayed in the application should not be granted against them. R/o.15.01.2023.
