State Vs. Naresh

ORDER BELOW EXH-1

The prosecution has filed an application seeking withdrawal of prosecution in terms of Section 321 of the Code of Criminal Procedure. The application is supported by a letter issued by the assistant Director and public Prosecutor, Jalna contending the reference of the Government Resolution (GR) No. PRO-1221, dated 20.09.2022, of the Government of Maharashtra, recommending withdrawal in public interest and after considering the law and facts of the case.

2. The learned Public Prosecutor submits that the allegations against the accused do not warrant continued criminal proceedings. Considering the overall circumstances of the matter the Government has sanctioned withdrawal of prosecution, and permission of this court is necessary.

3. Perused the application under Section 321 of the CrPC. The public prosecutor may, with the consent of the court, withdraw from the prosecution at any stage of the trial, provided that the withdrawal is in the interest of justice, and the accused will not be prejudiced by such withdrawal. I have carefully considered the application, accompanying Government Reference, and the

submissions of the prosecution find that the prosecution has been sanctioned to be withdrawn by the Government competent authority. Hence, I pass following order.

Order

1. The proceeding is disposed of as withdrawn.
2. All the accused are acquitted for the offence punishable under section 188, 269, 270 of the Indian Penal Code, section 51 (b) Disaster Managment Act and section 3 Epidemic Diseases Act.
