This is an application for grant of Heir-ship Certificate under Bombay Regulation Act 1827.

2] According to the applicants, Applicant No.1 to 3 and 5 being grandsons and applicant No.4 being grand-daughter of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale, who died on 24/06/1990. Moreover, grandmother of the applicants namely Parubai Yamaji Kajale also died on 19.02.1999. Deceased Yamaji Kajale had two sons ie. Laxman Yamaji Kajale who died on 29.11.2018 and Ramnath Yamaji Kajale died on 27.02.2020. Therefore, applicants are only legal heirs of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale. The applicant required heir-ship certificate for recording their names in various Government offices as well as Semi Government Office. Hence, this application for grant of heir-ship certificate.

3] After filing of application, the public notice was issued in respect of heirship. It was duly published in the daily newspaper 'Anandnagri' dated 03/01/2026. In response to said public notice, no one appeared or filed objection to the claim of heir-ship of applicants.

4] In support of their claim, applicant No.5 Sachin Ramnath Kajale filed affidavit of examination-in-chief at Exh.9. He has categorically stated that they are only legal heirs of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale. The applicants have also filed on record, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale at Exh.11,

verified copy of death certificate of deceased Parubai Yamaji Kajale at Exh.12, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Ramnath Yamaji Kajale at Exh.13, verified copy of death certificate of deceased Laxman Yamaji Kajale at Exh.14, verified copies of Adhar cards of the applicants at Exh.15 to 19 respectively. Applicants have closed their evidence vide Pursis at Exh.20.

5] After considering the pleading, evidence of applicant, documents on record and submission of learned counsel for the applicants, this Court is of the opinion that issuance of heir-ship certificate is merely formal recognition as an heir of deceased. It appears from record that applicants are only legal heirs of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale. Admittedly, names of the competent legal heirs ought to be recorded in the official record and revenue record. There is no denial to the rights of applicants. All the documents and evidence before Court is sufficient to issue heir-ship certificate in the name of applicant being heir. Hence, following order.

::ORDER::

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Heir-ship Certificate in the name of Applicant No.1 Kishor Laxman Kajale, applicant No.2 Anil Laxman Kajale, applicant No.3 Sunil Laxman Kajale, applicant No.4 Sharda Dipak Chahare, applicant No.5 Sachin Ramnath Kajale declaring them to be recognized heir of deceased Yamaji Kondiram Kajale on depositing requisite Court fee Stamp as per rules.
