REGULAR BAIL APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 483 OF BNSS

Present : Shri Brijesh Rana, Advocate for the applicant-accused.

ORDER

This order shall dispose of the bail application under Section
483 of the BNSS moved by petitioner-accused Parveen.

2. F.I.R No. 137 under sections 21(b), 29 of NDPS Act and 61

Excise Act was registered at P.S. Rajound on 01.08.2026 on the complaint of P/SI Ravi Kumar.

3. In the bail application, it is stated that petitioner-accused was innocent and had been falsely implicated in the present case. It is stated that the petitioner-accused is in judicial custody since 01.08.2026 and no recovery is pending in this case. Petitioner-accused has undertaken to abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed upon him by the Court.

4. No reply to this bail application has been filed by the prosecution.

5. I have heard Sh. Brijesh Rana, learned counsel for the petitioner-accused and Sh. Vikas Sharma, learned Public Prosecutor for the State and have also gone through the case file very carefully.

6. Brief facts of the prosecution case are that on 01.08.2026, the police arrested a person namely Parveen (petitioner-accused) on the basis of secret information and during search, 6.25 grams of Heroin/Chitta and two litres of illicit liquor was recovered. His disclosure statement was recorded.

7. The contraband 6.25 grams of Heroin/Chitta involved in this case is of intermediate quantity. The petitioner-accused is in custody since 01.08.2026. The trial is likely to take a considerable time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner-accused further in custody. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner-accused is admitted to regular bail on his

furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. Papers be tagged with the main file.
